This term our Change4Life group are going ice skating at the Link Centre on a Friday afternoon.

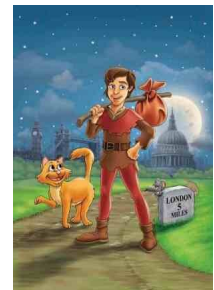
### Christmas Lunch Thursday 18th December
