Please remember to fill in WOW slips for your child. We want to know about the fantastic things that your child does at home. If you are out of slips then please see a member of staff for some more.

Over the half term break, please practise reading and writing the tricky words attached to your child's phonics book. Lots of us are struggling to remember them so the more practise we get the better.

PE kits have been sent home this week ready to be washed over half term. Please check your child's PE kit carefully. If you notice any items in there that don't belong to them then please return them ASAP as we have had lots going missing throughout the term.

Today we are sending home your child's 'Experience Passport'. When they have completed an 'experience' outside of school, tick it/sign it or write us a note in their HASP book and we will stamp it. When they have 30 stamps they will receive their Bronze sticker, 40 stamps will be their Silver and 50 will be their Gold. This passport is to last until the end of Key Stage 1 (Year 2), so there is no rush to do everything in half term!

Please encourage your child to continue to practise getting dressed and undressed independently at home. Some children are still struggling with this at school. One of the Early Learning Goals, which children are working to get by the end of Reception, is 'They manage their own basic hygiene and personal needs successfully, including dressing and going to the toilet independently'.
